Triduum of Mercy

In an effort to immediately focus attention on the Jubilee of Mercy, Bishop Sullivan asks that each deanery coordinate efforts to provide the Sacrament of Reconciliation on three consecutive nights, Tuesday, December 15, Wednesday, December 16 and Thursday, December 17. The Triduum of Mercy is an opportunity for the parishes of the deanery to work together to celebrate the Father's mercy by offering Advent Penance Services and sharing resources so as to not overburden any one parish.

Three different parishes in the deanery should be selected – each to host one evening of the Triduum of Mercy. The priests of the deanery are asked to assist in hearing confessions on at least one evening. The proposed ritual for the Penance Service is included in this packet.

The deans are asked to complete the TRIDUUM OF MERCY FORM in this packet and return it to Anna Summers by November 6, 2015 (fax 856.338.0376).

Once received, flyers particular to each deanery will be created and provided to the parishes of the deanery for use in advertising the Triduum of Mercy. The Jubilee Committee will likewise insure that the information for each celebration is published in the Catholic Star Herald.
