Itinerary

July 20th – Depart Newark on overnight flight, United #25 to Shannon at 7:35pm.

July 21st – *Céad míle fáilte!* Arrive Shannon Airport at 7:35am. Meet our Irish driver/guide in the arrivals hall and start our Irish journey with a stop for **complimentary tea & scones** and an opportunity to stretch our legs a little after our international flight. On our way to County Kerry we will visit the pretty town of Adare, known for its thatched roof cottages. We'll continue on to the colorful town of Sneem where we will spend the next three nights. Take a walk or relax at the hotel before joining the group for dinner.

Overnight: Sneem Hotel, Sneem, Co. Kerry (D)

July 22nd – Today we'll take a scenic tour of the **Ring of Kerry**. The Ring of Kerry is one of the most spectacular scenic drives in all of Ireland. Above all, the Ring of Kerry provides an amazing insight into the ancient heritage of Ireland. See the Iron Age Forts & Ogham Stones, old monasteries and a landscape carved out of rock by the last Ice Age 10,000 years ago. Return to Sneem in the afternoon with time to explore the town on your own before dinner this evening.

Overnight: Sneem Hotel, Sneem, Co. Kerry (B, D)

July 23rd – After breakfast we'll travel along the **Dingle Peninsula** to delight in the stunning views of the Slieve Mish Mountains, the shoreline of Dingle Bay and the open Atlantic Ocean. At the tip of the Peninsula, near Sleah Head, Ireland's most Western point we will be able to see the Basket Islands offshore. Return to Sneem in the afternoon with the rest of the day free.

Overnight: Sneem Hotel, Sneem, Co. Kerry (B)

July 24th – After breakfast we'll visit **Blarney Castle** where those energetic enough will have an opportunity to climb the 104 steps to kiss the stone, located in the battlements, and gain "the gift of the gab." On the way to Dublin we'll visit the **Rock of Cashel**, traditional seat of the kings of Munster dating from the 12th and 13th centuries. After an audio/visual presentation there will be time to stroll the grounds on our own and take some photographs of this stunning location. Tonight we'll enjoy dinner together at our hotel.

Overnight: Camden Court, Dublin (B, D)

July 25th – This morning Enjoy an orientation **sightseeing tour of Dublin City** to explore the elegant Georgian squares and houses, colorful parks, and bustling shopping areas. We'll stop for a visit to **St. Patrick's Cathedral**. Our tour will end at the **Guinness Storehouse**, Ireland's number one visitor attraction. Enjoy a perfect pint over-looking the city in the Gravity Bar. The remainder of the day is free to explore this historic city. Tonight enjoy dinner and entertainment at **The Brazen Head**, known as the oldest pub in Ireland. Dine in a candlelit room and be mesmerized by the storytelling of a local Irishman who will narrate the history, folklore and myths of times past and present. Afterwards you can head downstairs to the bar for some lively music by the locals!

Overnight: Camden Court, Dublin (B, D)

July 26th – This morning we'll take a trip outside of Dublin to the **Irish National Stud**. The Irish National Stud belongs to the people of Ireland but prides itself on being enjoyed and appreciated by visitors from all parts of the globe. Nowhere better symbolizes all that is great about County Kildare, the beating heart of Ireland's thoroughbred industry, than the stud, a unique attraction of outstanding natural beauty that is home to some of the most magnificent horses and sumptuous gardens to be found anywhere in the world. We'll return to Dublin this afternoon where the remainder of the day will be free to explore the city independently.

Overnight: Camden Court, Dublin (B)

July 27th – On our way to Belfast we'll visit **Newgrange or Knowth**, designated a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. Built around 3200 BC, it is estimated that the construction of the Passage Tombs at Newgrange & Knowth would have taken a work force of 300 at least 20 years. We'll continue on to Belfast where we will have time to relax and explore before dinner.

Overnight: The Europa, Belfast (B, D)

July 28th – We will visit **Titanic Belfast**, a must see visit in any tour of Northern Ireland. It is located in the heart of Belfast, on the slipways where RMS *Titanic* was built. Inside this iconic building, we will re-live the entire *Titanic* story from her birth in Belfast to the fateful maiden voyage and her eventual discovery on the seabed. Next a **local guide will take us on a two-hour tour** through Belfast City, rich in Victorian and Edwardian architecture followed by free time in Belfast.

Overnight: The Europa, Belfast (B)

July 29th – Today we will visit the **Giant's Causeway**, a mass of 40,000 hexagonal basalt columns formed over 60 million years ago. Legends about giants abound, especially Finn McCool, a hardy Ulster hero. Later we'll spend some time in Derry. A **local guide will take us on a walking tour** around Derry still mostly encircled by its medieval city walls. They are among the best-preserved city fortifications in the Western World. We will learn about the city's fascinating history while enjoying some spectacular scenery.

Overnight: The Europa, Belfast (B, D)

July 30th – After breakfast we will depart Belfast and begin making our way to Cabra Castle for our last night in Ireland. Along the way we will visit **The Saint Patrick Visitor Centre** in Downpatrick. The center is purpose-built to tell the story of St Patrick. Downpatrick is one of Ireland's most ancient and historic towns. Saint Patrick began his mission to Ireland here in 432 AD and when he died he was buried on what is now Cathedral Hill. Saints Bridget and Saint Columkille came to be buried here with Saint Patrick in this part of Ireland called Saint Patrick's Country. Located within the grounds of Down Cathedral, Patrick's Grave is still a place of pilgrimage on St Patrick's Day. Spend the remainder of the day enjoying the castle before our farewell diner this evening.

Overnight: Cabra Castle, Kingscourt, Co. Cavan (B, D)

July 31st – After breakfast depart for the Dublin Airport for your return flight to Newark on United #22 at 9:00am, arriving Newark at 11:10am. **(B)**
