Maierhofer. She later transferred to Hochschule für Musik in Freiburg, Germany, where she continued her studies under Mr. Maierhofer. Susanna currently serves as Principal Organist at St. Andrew the Apostle Catholic Church in Gibbsboro, New Jersey. She and her husband, Matthew Orap, reside in Voorhees Township, where he attends medical school.
