Generous Stewards

“You, son of man, I have appointed watchman for the house of Israel...” - EZEKIEL 33:7

Many of us are generous with our gifts. However, many of us are not generous in proportion to the gifts we have been given. How often do we give at the minimum level required? Remember, the Lord calls us to nurture and develop our gifts and to give back with increase. He calls us as **stewards** to be generous with all the gifts, especially the one that means the most to us.
